NETTLES ISLAND RULES

Rule 2.3(b) All **guests or visitors** must be called in to the gate house prior to their arrival.

Rule 4.2, 4.5, 4.7, 4.11 All **Pets** must be registered with the Nettles Island Condo Office. **Pets** shall not be permitted on outdoor recreational areas or other unit owner's private property, without written permission from unit property owner. Pets are not permitted inside common element restrooms. **Pet Owners** must pick up all solid waste of their pets and dispose of such waste in an appropriate container. (Do not use private trash cans without permission.) **Pets** are permitted in West Recreation Parking Lot and West Recreation walkways on golf carts and vehicles only, with the exception of special events as permitted by the Board of Directors. Dogs may be carried.

Rule 5.3(a, b1) All **Golf Carts** must have 2021 sticker. **Golf Cart Drivers** must be 16 years old with I.D. or 14 years old with adult over the age of 18.

COVID VACCINE INFO: Second vaccine for second series of vaccinations on Nettles Island, Monday, April 12th beginning at 11:30am in the Main Hall. Make sure to bring Covid vaccination card from first vaccine.

Special thanks to our NI Nurses for their work in getting over 1,000 of our residents vaccinated in January/February (both vaccines done!) **and now another 200+** in March/April (first vaccine done and second one done this Monday!). **The nurses thank everyone who made it possible.** St. Lucie and Martin County Board of Health Depts. are giving appointments. If you are a Cleveland Clinic patient, you can get the "MyChart" app. Once in the "MyChart" app, go to "messages" and leave a request for the Covid vaccine. They will send back a message with a link to get an appointment. If you are a Veteran, the VA is giving the vaccine. Publix is also scheduling appointments.
