NETTLES ISLAND, INC. GUIDELINES FOR RE-OPENING RECREATIONAL FACILITIES EFFECTIVE MAY 9, 2020

IMPORTANT NOTICE

As the recreational facilities re-open, it is understood that all facilities are available on a **“USE AT YOUR OWN RISK”** and **“Social Distancing of at least 6 feet required”** basis. All activities, such as tennis, pickleball, horseshoes, etc., will resume on a **“Sign-up-in-Advance”** basis. Nettles Island will provide the normal cleaning services, such as restrooms and showers; **residents will need to bring their own sanitizers and wipe down any other surfaces (such as pool lounges, court benches, clubhouse chairs, etc.) as they deem necessary.**

The following will remain closed for now: Gym/Exercise Room, Hot Tub/Whirlpool, Water fountains (residents will need to bring their own bottled water).

Bathhouses: In addition to the bathhouses that are currently open, bathhouse #9 will re-open effective May 7, 2020. Other bathhouses will open as adequate supplies (ie. paper products and soap) become available.

Sand box – will re-open May 9th.

Mini Golf course – will re-open May 9th. Residents will need to provide their own clubs and balls for play, and no equipment will be signed out from the Information Center yet (this will be re-evaluated at a later date).

Recreation Hall – will re-open May 9th. Clubs/Persons wanting to organize activities must schedule the same in advance with the Recreation Director, Adam Barr. Clubs/Persons who organize activities will be required to ensure social distancing.

Library – will re-open May 9th. Social distancing will be required, so there will be a limit on how many persons may be present in the library at the same time.

Pools – will re-open May 9th; hours of operation will be 7:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. for the pool by the Rec Hall and 7:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m. for the ocean pool. All persons coming to the pools **MUST DISPLAY A NETTLES ISLAND-ISSUED PINK TAG; this will be strictly enforced.** Persons at the pool must maintain social distancing of at least 6 ft. at all times. In order to help ensure proper social distancing, the Association will be limiting the volume of pool

furniture that is placed on the pool decks. **If these guidelines are not followed, the Association will be forced to shut down the pools again.**

Tennis Courts – will re-open May 9th, only on a **sign-up-in-advance** basis. Players should bring their own rackets and balls, and their own supply of hand sanitizer and/or sanitizing wipes. Contact: Tanya Mikel

Pickleball – will re-open May 9th, only on a **sign-up-in-advance** basis for one-hour time slots with a maximum of 4 players only. Contact: Tammy Gibson

Horseshoes – will re-open May 9th, only on a **sign-up-in-advance** basis. Players are to supply their own hand sanitizer and/or sanitizing wipes. Spectators will be required to stay behind the fence, wear face masks, and maintain social distance. Contact: Peter or Ro Leloia
