

As the winter/ spring season winds down, the recycling bin on the tennis courts will also be removed. If anyone has any tennis balls to recycle, either dispose of them in the green bin (inside the east court to the left of the Sally Sprague wall) OR drop them off in my driveway - lot 1093 (Porpoise) - **by the end of this week, April 4th.**

As of today, I have recycled a total of 2,260 tennis balls from you! Good start. The company no longer charges \$15 for the shipping label as they have a sponsor.

Any of you, wherever you live, can recycle tennis balls.
